## God Loves You, Flaws and All

*So let's come near God with pure hearts and a confidence that comes from having faith. (Hebrews 10:22)*

It's finally summer, and many families are loading up the car and hitting the open road. Our family is no different. We're anxiously anticipating a weeklong beach vacation. In fact, I can already hear the ocean calling my name.

I love everything about beach vacations—the ocean breeze, reading a book under a big umbrella, watching dolphins play in the ocean, sinking my toes into the sand, walking the beach with my handsome husband at sunset, etc. I love it all—except the bathing suit part.

Seriously, is there anything more humbling than standing in front of a dressing room mirror, under those unforgiving fluorescent lights, trying on bathing suit after bathing suit? I think not. I dread it every year. Because no matter how many miles you've logged in previous months, no matter how many crunches you've crunched, no matter how many desserts you've passed up, bathing suits show every imperfection. While you might be able to hide a few dimples underneath blue jeans or a nice black dress with the help of Spanx, you're not hiding anything in a bikini. A bathing suit provides little camouflage.

That's pretty much how it is with God. You might be able

to fake-grin your way through church. You might be able to “play Christian” in front of your friends and family. But when you enter the throne room, it's like wearing your bathing suit before God. You can't hide any imperfections from him. He sees it all. That truth used to horrify me—even more than trying on bathing suits—but not anymore. Because now I know how God truly sees me.

God gave us Jesus to take care of our sin because God knew we'd be flawed. No matter how many good deeds we do. No matter how many chapters of the Bible we read each day. No matter how many casseroles we bake for church functions. We can never be good enough for God. We can't earn our way into God's favor or his kingdom. All we have to do is ask Jesus to be the Lord of our lives, and we're “in.” Then, whenever we enter the throne room, God sees us through “the Jesus filter,” and all he sees is perfection.

If you haven't asked Jesus to take away your sin and be the Lord of your life, why not take care of that today? Just pray: *Father God, I confess that I have sinned and fallen short of your glory, as the Word says, but I wish to leave that old life behind and live for you the rest of my days. I believe that Jesus is your son and that he died for my sins, and I am so thankful. I ask you, Lord, to come into my heart. I make you my Lord and Savior this very moment. And I praise you for this new beginning. In Jesus' Mighty Name. Amen.*

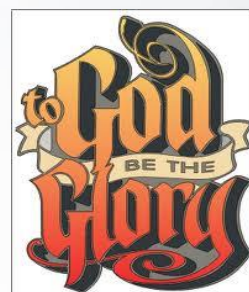

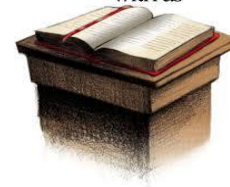

Use this excerpt from *Time Out for the Spirit* to help you feel God's comfort. By Lucile Allen

**READ:** *Men listened to me and waited, and kept silence for my counsel. Job 29:21*

**REFLECT:** Sometimes, I get frustrated with those seemingly endless seasons when God is so silent it's easy to doubt that He's ever spoken at all. During those times, I try to reflect on the many ways I've heard God's voice in the past, times when He has:

- directed, corrected, and loved me through the voice of a family member, a friend, a teacher or a preacher;

### **Our Gifts for His Kingdom (1 Corinthians 12:4-7)**

Many people hear the word "serve" and feel that they do not have the necessary qualities to make a difference in others' lives. This is true – apart from God. But He has gifted each of us in unique ways with a purpose in mind. His plan for us involves using these talents to serve Him for the good of others. Satan would like us to believe otherwise. Our enemy wants us to notice what others are doing and then to feel inferior. For instance, I have heard women say, "I am just a homemaker." They see people preaching and singing in the choir and wish they could accomplish something so great for God. Friends, nothing could be further from the truth. An enormous responsibility rests with those who train their children in righteousness. In fact, the Holy Spirit has gifted each believer for specific work in God's kingdom. Scripture explains this idea by a comparison with a human body: Each person has gifts and purposes that make the entire system function well. But if the heel wants the eye's role, the whole being will lose balance. Each part is crucial, even though some aren't as noticeable as others. Truthfully, those with less apparent talents have an advantage because pride and self-sufficiency may not be so great a temptation. Notice the words Peter used to define himself: "a bond-servant and apostle of Jesus Christ" (2 Pet. 1:1). He was no longer a man motivated by self-interest. Once He began to follow Jesus, he saw himself as a servant of God. We, too, are called to serve the King of Kings with whatever abilities we are given. (Submitted by: The Trustee & Finance Ministry)

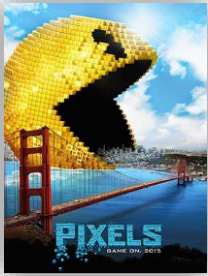

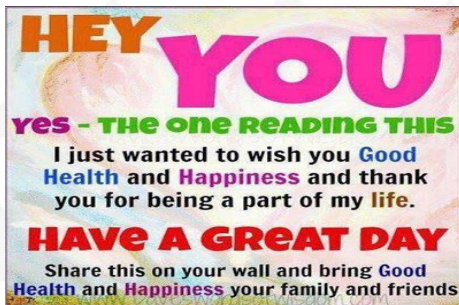
