Demonstrate the Love of Jesus

God demonstrates His own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us. Romans 5:8

Being aware of the needs of others was a specialty of Jesus. He knew what we needed before we ever had a chance to ask. He was a good listener. He listened not only with his ears, but also with his heart. He had compassion and knew that to sit back and wish people well was not enough. He knew that we could not pay for our own sins. He gave us a wonderful example of how to act on behalf of others.

He showed us that he cared. I believe we must follow his example and show others that we care. We don't have to know them to want something good to happen to them. We know that prayer is always needed. It is one of the most loving things that we can do. We can pray for friends, family, enemies, and acquaintances. We can pray for people we see out shopping with their children. We pray for disabled people we encounter. Perhaps God will put someone in your path today.

My prayer point is that you don't need money to pray for someone, it is a powerful gift that we can give to show that we care. Look around you today and begin to demonstrate the love of Jesus. Provide a financial blessing or be of service in another way, if you can. Demonstrate your love—and God's—to those around you.

HEALTH CARE CORNER

August is National Immunization and Psoriasis Awareness Month



Immunization, or vaccination, helps prevent dangerous and sometimes deadly diseases. To stay protected against serious illnesses like the flu. measles, and pneumonia, adults need to get their shots – just like kids do. **National Immunization Awareness** Month is a great time to promote vaccines and remind family, friends, and coworkers to stay up to date on their shots. Talk to friends and family members about how vaccines aren't just for kids. People of all ages can get shots to protect them from serious diseases. Encourage people in your community to get the flu vaccine every year.



Each August, the National Psoriasis Foundation (NPF) sponsors Psoriasis Awareness Month, dedicated to raising awareness, educating the public and dispelling myths about the disease. Psoriasis is a chronic, noncontagious, genetic autoimmune disease that appears on the skin in red, scaly patches that itch, crack and bleed. It is the most common autoimmune disease in the country, affecting approximately 7.5 million Americans. To develop psoriasis, a person must have a combination of the genes that cause psoriasis and be exposed to external "triggers." Triggers include stress; injury to the skin, such as a tattoo or a scrape; smoking; and certain infections. There is no cure for psoriasis, but many treatment options are available.


