The Message of Easter

God promises that there is nothing to fear in life or even death itself.

Easter is here-with its promise of spring, its big family meals, its inevitable chocolate bunnies and jellybeans. But what does Easter really mean? What message does it bring to us humans knee-deep in messes of our own making?

First and foremost, it means that we serve a risen Savior. The grave could not hold Christ; he defeated death. He paid the price for our sin with his own blood. And the consequences for us are *huge*.

"For if, while we were God's enemies, we were reconciled to him through the death of his Son, how much more, having been reconciled, shall we be saved through his life!" (Romans 5:10). Because Christ lives, we will live, too-both in this life and in the life to come. Jesus said, "I am the resurrection and the life. The one who believes in me will live, even though they die; and whoever lives by believing in me will never die" (John 11:25-26).

The message of Easter was first spoken to two women at Jesus' tomb, in these simple words: "Do not be afraid...for He is risen" (Matthew 28:5-6). Jesus is with us and gives us his ability to overcome any defeat. The true Christian realizes that he, with Christ, rises above every setback, every obstacle and enters into the true meaning of living.

The Easter message tells us: You need not be afraid of anything–not life with all its insecurities, its conflicts, its uncertainties; not afraid of even death itself. You need have no fear–no fear!

When your spirit is filled with the unshakable strength of God in the name of Jesus Christ, you get faith so deeply planted within you that when crisis hit you—as they sometimes do suddenly—you automatically can look life in the face and not be afraid. You can say with the Apostle Paul, "For I am convinced that neither death nor life, neither angels nor demons, neither the present nor the future, nor any powers, neither height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord" (Romans 8:38-39).

People often write to me about experiences they have which speak to them of the nearness of God. These little glimpses of heaven help us to open our eyes and ears to God's presence in our lives.

We pray at times as if we expect God to be available whenever we want Him to be and to answer our prayers immediately. Perhaps it's better to live in a prayerful awareness of the nearness of God, surrounded by angelic beings, deeply aware of our needs and ready to help at all times. Prayer enables us to be aware of and receptive to this gift which God the Father made possible through the life, death and resurrection of His Divine Son.

A distraught friend drives a good distance to visit a chapel, which is closed when she arrives. As she sits on the steps and weeps, two beautiful red cardinals perch nearby and bring her comfort.

The elderly mother who cannot walk far prays for a parking space close to the store. As she comes up the lane, a woman pulls out of a space next to the door and smiles at her.

A lost medal shows up in the dark after the owner senses she needs to go outside with a flashlight and look in a certain spot.

What does it mean when an old and cherished rosary disappears and cannot be found, even when the nightstand where it is kept is turned upside down and emptied, to no avail. Prayers are heavensent with vigor and when the drawer is opened again, the rosary is sitting on top of all the books in plain sight.

It means that when we are told in Scripture that every hair on our head is known to God, it is true. We have only to believe. Glimpses of heaven happen to us every day, if only we have eyes to see.

They were filled with joy when they saw the Lord! John 20:20 (NLT)

John 20 is such a sweet chapter. I love it because I can imagine the sheer joy that plunked itself right in the midst of Jesus's followers whom He appeared to after His Resurrection. But His appearing isn't all that I love, as if that weren't enough. I particularly love that He showed up in the middle of His followers' fears, and He replaced those fears with joy.

All who know Him as Savior will experience that transformation one day when He returns without warning to rescue His own. What a shift for the heart, to go from pain and fear to soar with the Lord of heaven and earth. But in the meantime, He gives us His Spirit, Who is here for us now. Just as His disciples didn't have to be masters of faith to be worthy of His presence, we don't have to have it "all together" to earn His time either.

No matter how discombobulated I may be these days, no matter how crazy this day seems, my Jesus will show up for me, and His arrival will bring me joy and neutralize fear. I want more of that! Later in that chapter, Jesus appeared to Thomas, who didn't believe Jesus was present until Thomas could see Him. To that, Jesus replied, "You believe because you have seen me. Blessed are those who haven't seen me and believe anyway" (verse 29).

I want more joy from Jesus' presence, but I also want His blessing for believing He is with me even when I can't see Him, even when fear hovers. Joy and blessing and freedom from fear... I'm going for the whole package. By His grace, I will trust Him when I can't see Him and I'll go ahead and feel the joy now.

Faith Step: Ask Jesus to fill you with joy and blessing because you believe He is with you right now.



National KIDNEY Month

Kidney disease develops when kidneys lose their ability to remove waste and maintain fluid and chemical balances in the body. The severity of CKD depends on how well the kidneys filter wastes from the blood.

High-risk populations include those with diabetes, high blood pressure, cardiovascular disease and family history of kidney disease. Diabetes is the number one cause of kidney disease and high blood pressure is second leading cause (source: USRDS 2011 Atlas of ESRD); according to the U.S. Centers for Disease Control, 1 in 3 with diabetes and 1 in 5 with high blood pressure have kidney disease.

According to the U.S. Centers for Disease Control, African Americans are nearly 3.5 times more likely to be diagnosed with kidney failure compared to Caucasians. Other high-risk groups include Hispanics, Asian Americans, Pacific Islanders, Native Americans and seniors 65 and older.

Anyone 18 years old or older with diabetes, high blood pressure, cardiovascular disease or a family history of kidney disease should be screened for kidney disease

Because there are often no symptoms of kidney disease, laboratory tests are critical.

In many cases, kidney failure can be prevented or delayed through early detection and proper treatment of underlying diseases, such as diabetes and high blood pressure to slow additional damage to the kidneys.
