Commitment in Adversity

When I made a commitment to marry a preacher, it was with joy, excitement and the dream of serving God with all my heart. I was not prepared for serious and debilitating illness, the miscarriage of a baby, the trauma of a financially troubled church and personal attacks from the family of faith.

Within one of my husband's sermons, I found a nugget of hope: "Our adversities are God's universities." The adversities drove me to God and God had what I needed to endure and fulfill the commitment I had made.

In Ruth 1:16-17, the innocent young widow Ruth expressed her passionate and devoted love for her old and bitter mother-in-law. It was not Naomi's beauty, wealth or even joyfulness that drew Ruth to her, for all of these had long since fallen away. Rather it was Naomi's faith in the living God, her spiritual wisdom and her consistent piety that bound the young pagan widow to her. Ruth made a commitment to travel, live and pursue life with Naomi, to accept her God and even to die and be buried in Naomi's homeland. Her commitment was not just with loving words and well-meaning feelings, as her sister-in-law Orpah (Ruth 1:14), but with purposeful love and devoted deeds.

Commitment must be fueled not merely by head knowledge but also by heart determination. Ruth had nothing to offer to Naomi or to God but herself, and that she gave willingly and eagerly. Every woman, whatever her circumstances or position, has at least that to give the Savior, and it is enough.

The 10 Virtues of the Proverbs 31 Woman

1. Faith – A Virtuous Woman <u>serves God with all of her heart, mind, and soul</u>. She seeks His will for her life and follows His ways. (Proverbs 31: 26, Proverbs 31: 29 – 31, Matthew 22: 37, John 14: 15, Psalm 119: 15)

2. Marriage – A Virtuous Woman <u>respects her husband</u>. She does him good all the days of her life. She is trustworthy and a <u>helpmeet</u>. (Proverbs 31: 11- 12, Proverbs 31: 23, Proverbs 31: 28, 1 Peter 3, Ephesians 5, Genesis 2: 18)

3. Mothering – A Virtuous Woman <u>teaches her children</u> the ways of her Father in heaven. She <u>nurtures her</u> <u>children</u> with the love of Christ, disciplines them with care and wisdom, and <u>trains them in the way they should</u> <u>go</u>. (Proverbs 31: 28, Proverbs 31: 26, Proverbs 22: 6, Deuteronomy 6, Luke 18: 16)

4. Health – A Virtuous Woman <u>cares for her body</u>. She prepares <u>healthy food for her family</u>. (Proverbs 31: 14 – 15, Proverbs 31: 17, 1 Corinthians 6: 19, Genesis 1: 29, Daniel 1, Leviticus 11)

5. Service – A Virtuous Woman <u>serves her husband, her family, her friends, and her neighbors</u> with a gentle and loving spirit. She is charitable. (Proverbs 31: 12, Proverbs 31: 15, Proverbs 31: 20, 1 Corinthians 13: 13)

Charm is deceptive, and beauty is fleeting; but a woman who fears the Lord is to be praised. Proverbs 31:30

6. Finances – A Virtuous Woman seeks her husband's approval before making purchases and <u>spends money</u> <u>wisely</u>. She is careful to purchase quality items which her family needs. (Proverbs 31: 14, Proverbs 31: 16, Proverbs 31: 18, 1 Timothy 6: 10, Ephesians 5: 23, Deuteronomy 14: 22, Numbers 18: 26)

7. Industry – A Virtuous Woman <u>works willingly with her hands</u>. She sings praises to God and does not grumble while completing her tasks. (Proverbs 31: 13, Proverbs 31: 16, Proverbs 31: 24, Proverbs 31: 31, Philippians 2: 14)

8. Homemaking – A Virtuous Woman is a homemaker. She <u>creates an inviting atmosphere of warmth and love</u> for her family and guests. She uses hospitality to minister to those around her. (Proverbs 31: 15, Proverbs 31: 20 – 22, Proverbs 31: 27, Titus 2: 5, 1 Peter 4: 9, Hebrews 13: 2)

9. Time – A Virtuous Woman uses her time wisely. She works <u>diligently to complete her daily tasks</u>. She does not spend time dwelling on those things that do not please the Lord. (Proverbs 31: 13, Proverbs 31: 19, Proverbs 31: 27, Ecclesiastes 3, Proverbs 16: 9, Philippians 4:8)

10. Beauty – A Virtuous Woman is a woman of worth and beauty. She has the <u>inner beauty that only comes from</u> <u>Christ</u>. She uses her creativity and sense of style to create beauty in her life and the lives of her loved ones. (Proverbs 31: 10, Proverbs 31: 21 – 22, Proverbs 31: 24 - 25, Isaiah 61: 10, 1 Timothy 2: 9, 1 Peter 3: 1 – 6)



Health Care Ministry Corner

A stroke, sometimes called a brain attack, occurs when a blockage stops the flow of blood to the brain or when a blood vessel in or around the brain bursts. Although many people think of stroke as a condition that affects only older adults, strokes can and do occur in people of all ages. In fact, nearly a quarter of all strokes occur in people younger than age 65. Each year, almost 800,000 strokes occur in the United States. Strokes often lead to serious, life-changing complications that include Paralysis or weakness on one side of the body. Problems with thinking, awareness, attention, learning, judgment, and memory. Problems understanding or forming speech. Difficulty controlling or expressing emotions. Numbness or strange sensations. Pain in the hands and feet. Depression. Know your <u>ABCS</u> of health: Appropriate Aspirin therapy: Ask your doctor if taking aspirin is right for you. **B**lood pressure control: Keeping your blood pressure under control reduces your risk of heart attack and stroke. More than half of the world's stroke deaths are caused by elevated blood pressure levels. Cholesterol management: Get your cholesterol checked regularly and manage it with diet and physical activity or with medication, if needed. Smoking cessation: Get help at 1-800-QUIT-NOW. Exercise regularly. Eat a healthy diet that's low in sodium. Maintain a healthy weight. Prevent or control diabetes. Limit your alcohol intake (fewer than two drinks per day for men, or one drink per day for women). When responding to a stroke, every minute counts. The sooner a patient receives medical treatment, the lower the risk for death or disability. If you or someone you know exhibits the following signs or symptoms, call 9-1-1 immediately. Numbness or weakness of the face, arm, or leg, especially on one side of the body. Confusion, trouble speaking, or difficulty understanding. Trouble seeing in one or both eyes. Trouble walking, dizziness, or loss of balance and coordination. Severe headache with no known cause.
