That will lend us a helping hand?

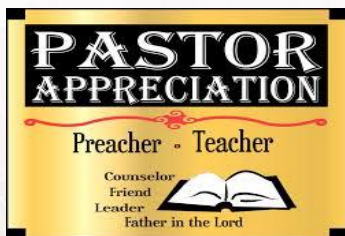
When you pray, put him at the top of the list

God Bless – The Pastor's Wife

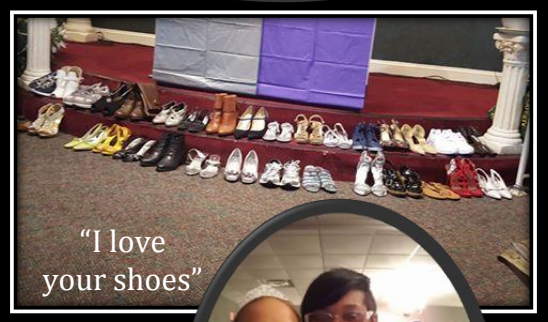
She will someday reach the end of her race

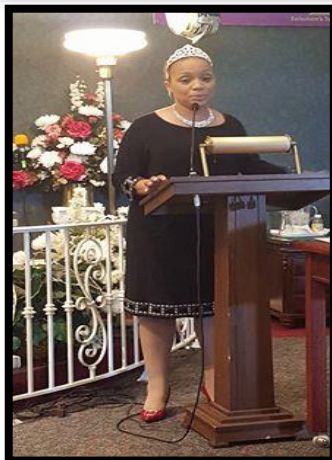

October is Breast Cancer Month

ABOUT NBCF

The National Breast Cancer Foundation's mission is to save lives by increasing awareness of breast cancer through education and by providing mammograms for those in need. NBCF accomplishes this mission through various initiatives. NBCF programs provide women help for today and hope for tomorrow.

What Is Breast Cancer Awareness Month?

Why do you see so much pink every **October**? October is Breast Cancer Awareness Month, which is an annual campaign by major breast cancer organizations to increase awareness of the disease. This includes educating the public about early detection, the cause, diagnosis, treatment, and support for survivors.

Breast Cancer Facts

Breast cancer is a disease in which malignant (cancer) cells form in the tissues of the breast. The damaged cells can invade surrounding tissue, but with [early detection](#) and [treatment](#), most people continue a normal life.

- One in eight women will be [diagnosed](#) with breast cancer in their lifetime.
- Breast cancer is the most commonly diagnosed cancer in women.
- Breast cancer is the second leading cause of death among women.
- Each year it is estimated that over 220,000 women in the United States will be diagnosed with breast cancer and more than 40,000 will die.
- Although [breast cancer in men](#) is rare, an estimated 2,150 men will be diagnosed with breast cancer and approximately 410 will die each year.

According to the [World Health Organization](#), breast cancer is the most common cancer among women worldwide, claiming the lives of hundreds of thousands of women each year and affecting countries at all levels of modernization.

In recent years, perhaps coinciding with the decline in prescriptive [hormone replacement therapy](#) after menopause, we have seen a gradual reduction in female breast cancer incidence rates among women aged 50 and older. Death rates from breast cancer have been declining since about 1990, in part to better due to screening and [early detection](#), increased awareness, and continually improving [treatment](#) options.

Causes of Breast Cancer

When you're told that you have breast cancer, it's natural to wonder what may have caused the disease. But no one knows the exact causes of breast cancer. Doctors seldom know why one woman develops breast cancer and another doesn't, and most women who have breast cancer will never be able to pinpoint an exact cause. What we do know is that breast cancer is always caused by damage to a cell's DNA.

Women with certain [risk factors](#) are more likely than others to develop breast cancer. A risk factor is something that may increase the chance of getting a disease. Some risk factors (such as drinking alcohol) can be avoided. But most risk factors (such as having a family history of breast cancer) can't be avoided. Having a risk factor does not mean that a woman will get breast cancer. Many women who have risk factors never develop breast cancer.

Male Breast Cancer

All people, whether male or female, are born with some breast cells and tissue. Even though males do not develop milk-producing breasts, a man's breast cells and tissue can still develop cancer. Even so, male breast cancer is very rare. Less than one percent of all breast cancer cases develop in men, and only one in a thousand men will ever be [diagnosed](#) with breast cancer.

Breast cancer in men is usually detected as a hard lump underneath the nipple and areola. Men carry a higher mortality than women do, primarily because awareness among men is less and they are less likely to assume a lump is breast cancer, which can cause a delay in seeking [treatment](#).

Of the men who develop breast cancer, the vast majority of those cases are [Infiltrating Ductal Carcinoma \(IDC\)](#), which means cells in or around the ducts begin to invade surrounding tissue. Very rarely, a man might be diagnosed with [inflammatory breast cancer](#), or Paget disease, of the nipple.

Male breast cancer can exhibit the same [symptoms](#) as breast cancer in women, including a lump. Anyone who notices anything unusual about their breasts, whether male or female, should contact their physician immediately. Survival rates and [treatment](#) for men with breast cancer are very similar to those for women. [Early detection](#) of breast cancer increases treatment options and often reduces the risk of dying from breast cancer.

Medicare Open Enrollment

Every year, Medicare's open enrollment period is
October 15 - December 7.

Medicare health and drug plans can make changes each year—things like cost, coverage, and what providers and pharmacies are in their networks. October 15 to December 7 is when all people with Medicare can change their Medicare health plans and prescription drug coverage for the following year to better meet their needs. People in a Medicare health or prescription drug plan should always review the materials their plans send them, like the "Evidence of Coverage" (EOC) and "Annual Notice of Change" (ANOC). If their plans are changing, they should make sure their plans will still meet their needs for the following year. If they're satisfied that their current plans will meet their needs for next year and it's still being offered, they don't need to do anything. 1-800-MEDICARE or Medicare.gov.
