## Four Ways to Make Your Christmas Happy... and Holy!

But, unfortunately, many of us get caught up in the rush and the pressure of the holiday season. When that happens, Christmas can seem more like a mad dash to the finish line than the reverent, expectant time it should be. Try these ideas to keep your Christmas happy and holy:

#### 1. Discover the positive power of "no."

It's easy to find yourself getting overextended (even with good activities!) and losing sight of your true priorities. So this year, why not be more mindful about what you commit to? Learn the art of saying "no" and making careful, prayerful choices when it comes to your time and energy. "Walk in wisdom… redeeming the time" (Colossians 4:5).

#### 2. Make someone else merry.

You probably won't have to look very far this year to find someone who could use a little kindness and generosity. A lonely widow, a single mother, a local inmate. Helping to make someone else's Christmas happy is sure to make you feel great, too. 'Truly I tell you, whatever you did for one of the least of these brothers and sisters of mine, you did for me" (Matthew 25:40).

#### 3. Wait in wonder.

It's hard to truly wait, to hope expectantly, when you are on the move. Advent is a time to commit to the wonder, to marvel at the coming of Christ into our world. Set aside some time to sit quietly, opening your mind and heart to this miracle. "Be still, and know that I am God" (Psalm 46:10).

#### 4. De-stress with the best book in the world.

Here are some Bible verses to commit to memory and repeat whenever you begin to feel tense.

- "Peace I leave with you, my peace I give to you" (John 14:27).
- "And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus" (Philippians 4:7).
- "Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest" (Matthew 11:28).

This Christmas, say "yes" to what's really important to you and a polite "no" to everything else. Look for ways to show kindness to people who need it. Remind yourself and your loved ones daily of the real reason why we celebrate: Christ has come to live among us. Hallelujah!



# 🤼 10 Great Bible Prayers 🙀

If you pray the <u>Lord's Prayer</u>, you already pray at least one of the <u>prayers</u> found in the Bible. But there are many that can provide help when you're not sure what to pray.

#### 1. A Prayer of Surrender

"Nevertheless, not as I will, but as You will." (Matthew 26:39, ESV)

## 2. A Prayer for Strength, Faith and Love

For this reason I bow my knees before the Father, [asking] that according to the riches of His glory He may grant you to be strengthened with power through His Spirit in your inner being, so that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith—that you, being rooted and grounded in love, may have strength to comprehend with all the saints what is the breadth and length and height and depth, and to know the love of Christ that surpasses knowledge, that you may be filled with all the fullness of God.

#### (Ephesians 3:14-19, ESV)

#### 3. A Prayer for Enlightenment

We ask God to give you complete knowledge of His will and to give you spiritual wisdom and understanding. Then the way you live will always honor and please the Lord, and your lives will produce every kind of good fruit. All the while, you will grow as you learn to know God better and better. We also pray that you will be strengthened with all His glorious power so you will have all the endurance and patience you need. May you be filled with joy, always thanking the Father. (Colossians 1:9-12, NLT)

## 4. A Prayer for Understanding and Favor

If it is true that you look favorably on me, let me know your ways so I may understand you more fully and continue to enjoy your favor. (Exodus 33:13, NLT)

#### 5. A Prayer for Blessing

The Lord bless you and keep you; the Lord make His face to shine upon you and be gracious to you; the Lord lift up His countenance upon you and give you peace. (Numbers 6:24-26, ESV)

#### 6. A Prayer for Influence and Protection

Oh, that You would bless me and expand my territory! Please be with me in all that I do, and keep me from all trouble and pain!
(1 Chronicles 4:10, NLT)

#### 7. A Prayer of Repentance

Purify me from my sins, and I will be clean; wash me, and I will be whiter than snow...Create in me a clean heart, O God, Renew a loyal spirit within me. Do not banish me from your presence, and don't

take your Holy Spirit from me. Restore to me the joy of your salvation, and make me willing to obey you. (Psalm 51:7, 10-12, NLT)

#### 8. A Prayer for Revival

God, I've heard what our ancestors say about You, and I'm stopped in my tracks, down on my knees. Do among us what You did among them. Work among us as you worked among them. (Habakkuk 3:2,

#### 9. A Prayer for Mercy

God, be merciful to me, a sinner. (<u>Luke</u> 18:13, ESV)

#### 10. A Prayer for Boldness

Give us, your servants, great boldness in preaching Your word. Stretch out Your hand with healing power; may miraculous signs and wonders be done through the name of Your holy servant Jesus.

These and many other Bible prayers make it easier to pray according to God's will. They can help you express yourself when words fail. And they can simultaneously enrich your knowledge of the Bible, confidence in prayer and sensitivity to the Spirit of God as you pray.




#### The Birth of Jesus

While Mary was still engaged to Joseph, she miraculously became pregnant through the Holy Spirit, as foretold to her by the angel. When Mary told Joseph she was pregnant, he had every right to feel disgraced. He knew the child was not his own, and Mary's apparent unfaithfulness carried a grave social stigma. Joseph not only had the right to divorce Mary, under Jewish law she could be put to death by stoning. Although Joseph's initial reaction was to break the engagement, the appropriate thing for a righteous man to do, he treated Mary with extreme kindness. He did not want to cause her further shame, so he decided to act quietly. But God sent an angel to Joseph in a dream to verify Mary's story and reassure him that his marriage to her was God's will. The angel explained that the child within Mary was conceived by the Holy Spirit, that his name would be Jesus and that he was the Messiah, God with us. When Joseph woke from his dream, he willingly obeyed God and took Mary home to be his wife, in spite of the public humiliation he would face. Perhaps this noble quality is one of the reasons God chose him to be the Messiah's earthly father. Joseph too must have wondered in awe as he remembered the words found in Isaiah 7:14, "Therefore the Lord himself will give you a sign: The virgin will be with child and will give birth to a son, and will call him Immanuel." At that time, Caesar Augustus decreed that a census be taken, and every person in the entire Roman world had to go to his own town to register. Joseph, being of the line of David, was required to go to Bethlehem to register with Mary. While in Bethlehem, Mary gave birth to Jesus. Probably due to the census, the inn was too crowded, and Mary gave birth in a crude stable. She wrapped the baby in cloths and placed him in a manger.
