#### **Turning Hurt into Love**

Instead of lashing out when someone close to you is treated unfairly, seek out a deeper, wider justice. by **Edie Melson** 

I think of myself as fairly level headed. I don't take offense easily, and I'm quick to forgive. However, when someone messes with my family, that description no longer applies. Things that would be quickly forgiven if aimed at me become huge stumbling blocks when aimed at those I love. And although my first reaction might be one of defense and retribution, I can't remember a single time when my interference helped. The only way I've found to make a difference is by turning to God.

Not only do I cry out and ask God to fight for my loved ones, but I also begin talking to Him about the person who <u>instigated the hurt</u>. I learned to do this the hard way. Because I tend to want justice—my version of justice—when a family member has been hurt.

I experienced this after one particularly ugly discussion with a friend who insisted that my son was a horrible person for signing up to serve in the <u>military</u>. I walked away from the conversation and took some time outside, begging God to make her see reason and feel the hurt that she had caused me and my son.

But God's justice is deeper and wider than that.

He loves the person behaving badly just as much as He loves me. That day He reminded me that although it goes against every ounce of how I'm feeling, going to God on their behalf makes a difference in how I feel about the situation. Somehow, it takes the hurt out of my heart and puts it at the foot of the cross, the place where I find perspective.

This doesn't mean we must reenter a relationship with the attacker, but it gives us the ability to move on and let God do the fighting for us—and for those we love. God the Father knows the hurt we're feeling on our child's behalf. He felt it when the world rejected His son, but only He knows how to turn that hurt into love.

#### 4 Simple Ways to Express Thanks to the Lord


By Dr. Paul Chappell - Thanksgiving Should Be A Way Of Life

- **1. Obey His Word -** Giving thanks unto the Lord assumes that we do indeed follow Him as our *Lord. And why call ye me, Lord, Lord, and do not the things which I say?—Luke* 6:46
- **2. Give Him Offerings -** One of the best ways to express thanksgiving is through thankful giving. Out of gratitude for what the Lord has done for you, give an extra offering to Him—invest in His work, or give to someone in need in His name. *Give unto the Lord the glory due unto his name: bring an offering, and come before him: worship the Lord in the beauty of holiness.*—1 Chronicles 16:29
- **3. Verbally Thank Him In Prayer -** Our verbal expressions of gratitude are a sacrifice of praise to Him. By him therefore let us offer the sacrifice of praise to God continually, that is, the fruit of our lips giving thanks to his name.—Hebrews 13:15
- **4. Thank People He Has Used In Your Life -** Take some time today to express gratitude to others who God has used in your life—your family, friends, teachers, mentors, spiritual leaders. Thank them for their investment in you, and tell them specifically how God has used them to provide for, encourage, and strengthen you. *I thank my God upon every remembrance of you*,—Philippians1:3. Thanksgiving at its best is *thanks giving*. Give the Lord thanks! *Oh that men would praise the Lord for his goodness, and for his wonderful works to the children of men!*—Psalm 107:8

#### A New Way to Pray the Lord's Prayer

Use this prayer tip for new understanding of the world's best loved prayer.

When you pray, are you ever uncertain that you're "doing it right"? Jesus' disciples felt that doubt and asked their Master to teach them how to pray. He gave them, and us, the short but profound formula that we call "The Lord's Prayer."

It contains everything necessary to the life of our body and soul and to our worship of God. But maybe the words have grown rote and stale to you, through repetition. If that's the case, consider trying to put the Lord's Prayer into your own words. For instance, for "Our Father, which art in Heaven," you might say, "God, what a miracle it is that even though You are so far above us, we can speak to You directly and know that You are listening."

For "Hallowed be thy Name," perhaps: "You are holy and mighty and worthy of all praise." And so on. By really thinking about the meaning of the words, and putting them into your own language, you can create a new connection with this pure source of spiritual strength.


