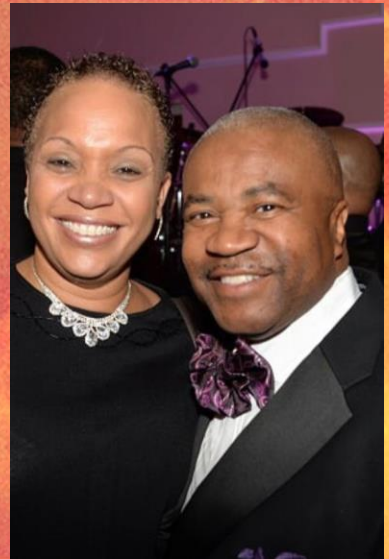

### **Be Resurrected!** by Norman Vincent Peale

Renew your life right now through the power of Jesus.

Do you want to live, really live, not simply exist, from one day to the next? Do you want to awaken to each day with joyful anticipation for what the day will bring? Then believe that life begins and continues through Jesus Christ. From him comes the amazing teaching, "If anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new" (2 Corinthians 5:17).

Easter is Jesus' great example of life-giving power, usually associated with eternity. But eternal life isn't only off in the future; it is now. You can be resurrected now. You don't have to wait until you die. You can be resurrected from other forms of death; indeed many of us are dead while we are alive.

What is life, actually? Life is when you are sensitive and caring. It is when you're full of joy, when you're vital, when you're effervescent, when you are excited with the possibilities of a new day. If that doesn't characterize you, maybe you need to be resurrected. ## 8 Prayers for Good Friday and Resurrection 2

Sunday by Bob Hostetler

[It's called "Holy Week,"](#) because for Christians, the journey from Palm Sunday to Easter commemorates the world-changing events that also change the life of anyone who identifies with Jesus Christ in His sacrificial suffering, death, burial and resurrection. For many, the week is characterized by much thought, worship and prayer. So here are eight prayers that can be prayed at any time, but may be helpful in driving home to your heart the profound meaning and blessing of this coming weekend:

### Four Good Friday Prayers

- 1) Lord Jesus, as you were crucified between two thieves, one who ridiculed and one who repented, so let any sacrifice and suffering I may offer be a testimony both to skeptics and seekers (see Luke 23:33).
- 2) Since my old self was crucified with Jesus, so that the body ruled by sin might be done away with, grant that I may no longer be a slave to sin, because anyone who has died has been set free from sin (Romans 6:6-7, NIV).
- 3) God, Your Word says that those who belong to Christ Jesus have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires; show it to be so in my life today (Galatians 5:24, NIV).
- 4) Father, in the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ the world has been crucified to me, and I to the world; remind me of that truth today (Galatians 6:14, NIV).

### Four Resurrection Sunday Prayers

- 1) Lord God, thank you that I was buried with Jesus through baptism into death in order that, just as He was raised from the dead through the glory of the Father, I too may live a new life. For if I have been united with Him in a death like his, I will certainly also be united with Him in a resurrection like His (Romans 6:4-5, NIV).
- 2) God, I died to the law through the body of Christ, that I might belong to Him who was raised from the dead, in order that I might bear fruit for You. Please let me fulfill Your purpose today (Romans 7:4, NIV).
- 3) Thank you, Lord Jesus, that because You were crucified in weakness but raised to life by God's power, let me, though weak, live by God's resurrection power in all I do (2 Corinthians 13:4, NIV).
- 4) God, thank you that I have been crucified with Christ and I no longer live, but Christ lives in me, and the life I now live in the body, I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me (Galatians 2:20).

### IBS---IRRITABLE BOWEL SYNDROME

Between [3 percent and 20 percent](#) of Americans experience irritable bowel syndrome (IBS) symptoms. The condition affects more women than men. Some people with IBS have minor symptoms. However, for others the symptoms are significant and disrupt daily life.

**What is IBS?** IBS is also known as spastic colon, irritable colon, mucous colitis, and spastic colitis. It is a separate condition from [inflammatory bowel disease](#) and isn't related to other bowel conditions. IBS is a group of intestinal symptoms that typically occur together. The symptoms vary in severity and duration from person to person. However, they last at least three months for at least three days per month. IBS can cause intestinal damage in some cases. However, that is not common. IBS doesn't increase your risk of gastrointestinal cancers, but it can still have a significant effect on your life.

**IBS symptoms** - The symptoms of IBS typically include: Cramping; abdominal pain; bloating and gas; constipation diarrhea

It's not uncommon for people with IBS to have episodes of both constipation and diarrhea. Symptoms such as bloating and gas typically go away after you have a bowel movement.

Symptoms of IBS aren't always persistent. They can resolve, only to come back. However, some people do have continuous symptoms.

### April Is Oral Cancer Awareness Month

Dental associations urge the public to get regular oral cancer screenings, and to self-check between examinations—early detection saves lives! Regular oral cancer examinations performed by your oral health professional remain the best method for detecting oral cancer in its early stages. *Check Your Mouth* encourages the public to regularly self-check for signs and symptoms of oral cancer between dental visits, and to see a dental professional if they do not improve or disappear after two-three weeks. Signs and symptoms of oral cancer caused by tobacco usage and/or excessive alcohol usage may include one or more of the following: Any sore or ulceration that does not heal within 14 days. A red, white, or black discoloration of the soft tissues of the mouth Any abnormality that bleeds easily when touched. A lump or hard spot in the tissue, usually border of the tongue. Tissue raised above that which surrounds it; a growth. A sore under a denture, which even after adjustment of the denture, that does not heal. A lump or thickening that develops in the mouth. A painless, firm, fixated lump felt on the outside of the neck, that has been there for at least two weeks. All these symptoms have the commonality of being persistent and not resolving. Signs and symptoms of HPV-caused oropharyngeal cancer persist longer than two-three weeks and may include one or more of the following: Hoarseness or sore throat that does not resolve. A painless, firm, fixated lump felt on the outside of the neck, which has been there for at least two weeks. Constant coughing that does not resolve. Difficulty swallowing; a sensation that food is getting caught in your throat. An earache on one side (unilateral) that persists for more than a few days. All of these symptoms have the commonality of being persistent and not resolving. Always call a dentist right away if there are any immediate concerns.
