

#### How to Pray Like Jesus by: Rick Hamlin

The Bible is full of examples of how important prayer was to Jesus. Here are a few. The Bible offers many models for prayer. The Psalms, for example, offer language to cover almost any circumstance in life. But again and again, I turn to the Gospels for reminders of just how important prayer was to Jesus and how He prayed. Here are a few verses:

In the morning, while it was still very dark, He got up and went out to a deserted place, and there He prayed. (Mark 1:35) Jesus could have talked to God anywhere, but He found it important to go off by Himself early in the morning, seeking a deserted place. Can we do any less?

I live in a teeming city with millions of people, but I can find that quiet place sitting on the sofa in the morning with my eyes closed.

"Those who find their life will lose it, and those who lose their life for My sake will find it." (Matthew 10:39)
Our minds are filled with distractions. Prayer is an opportunity to pay attention to them...and let them go. Catch and release.
When your mind wanders in prayer, don't fight it. Take note of the thought. And let it go. Losing our lives for God's sake...to

find them.

"...but I have prayed for you that your own faith may not fail." (Luke 22:32)

Jesus prayed for others. His disciples, those who came to Him in need. Prayer is a time to offer intersessions for all of our loved ones and those we don't even know. I like praying through the alphabet. There's always someone or a group that comes to mind for every letter.

"And I will ask the Father, and He will give you another Helper to be with you forever." (John 14:16)

We're not alone. As Jesus promised to His disciples, the Holy Spirit is our helper at hand whenever we need it. Let the Spirit give you the words—or no words—when all words fail.

"When you stand praying, forgive, if you have anything against anyone, so that your Father in heaven may also forgive you your sins." (Mark 11:25)


Prayer is an opportunity to become renewed. Forgiveness is a sure way to start. For me it's never a one-time thing but something I need to do over and over again. When I forgive others, I can begin the work of forgiving myself.

"My Father, if this cannot pass unless I drink it, Your will be done." (Matthew 26:42)

Sometimes prayer is a one-way tug-of-war. Think of Jesus in the Garden, asking God to be relieved of His suffering. The only conclusion is relinquishment. Not His will, but God's will. It might seem scary but there is always goodness ahead. For Jesus, yes there was the Crucifixion and then the Resurrection.

"Our Father who art in heaven, hallowed be Thy name..." (Matthew 6:9)

Most of us know these holy words, the prayer Jesus taught His disciples. I'm always grateful to be reminded it's in the first-person plural, not singular. Even when we're alone, we're praying with others and for others. The answers come to us all from *Our* Father.



#### Your Heavenly Father by: Elizabeth Peale Allen

Our loving Father in Heaven has a purpose for us beyond our limited human comprehension. Exactly who is God? He is a God of knowledge, as the Old Testament book of I Samuel tells us (2:3), but the Bible does not call him "Knowledge." He is a God of power (Psalm 145:11), but he is never called "Power." He *is* called "Father" in the Old Testament; Psalms 68:5 and 89:26, Isaiah 9:06 and 64:8, and Malachi 2:10 are examples of this. And of course this is his name throughout the New Testament.

Jesus taught his disciples to begin their prayers with, "Our Father in heaven..." (Matthew 6:9). To realize what that name "father" means, look at what Jesus said in Matthew 7:9-11. If your child was hungry and asked you for a piece of bread, would you hand him a stone to chew on? Of course not! Imperfect as you are (and I am, too), our Lord says even we know how to give good things to our children. Then how much more our Heavenly Father will give only the best to His children—you and me. No wonder that John, in his letter to believers, tells us, "God is love" (I John 4:8). Just as a child may not understand what his parent is doing, so we may not always be able to make sense of what's happening in our own lives. Our loving Father in Heaven may have a purpose beyond our limited human comprehension when He permits family tragedies, health crises, or financial setbacks to attack us. In the Old Testament book of Numbers, God authorized the high priest Aaron to give his people this blessing: "The Lord make His face shine upon you, and be gracious to you" (6:25). How a parent's face shines when he holds a small son or daughter in his lap, despite the wrong things that child may have done! And our Heavenly Father's face shines on us today simply because we are His children, despite our sins and failures. Why not spend some time with your Father today?


#### 4 Blessings for Fathers by: Bob Hostetler

Whether you write them in a card or pray them from a distance, these prayers will bless any father (or father figure). Father's Day has long occupied an important place in American life. Celebrated on the third Sunday in June, it offers a chance to honor those fathers—or father figures—who have made a difference in your life. What better way is there to honor someone than with a prayer of blessing? Though the best way to pray a blessing over someone is to do so aloud, in their presence, and preferably with a meaningful touch such as a hand on the shoulder or head. But the following blessings can also be handwritten in a card, sent via text or email, and prayed from a distance:

- 1) **The Aaronic Blessing:** The Lord bless you and keep you; the Lord make his face shine on you and be gracious to you; the Lord turn his face toward you and give you peace. (Numbers 6:24-26, NIV).
- 2) An Old Irish Blessing: May the road rise up to meet you. May the wind always be at your back. May the sun shine warm upon your face, and rains fall soft upon your fields. And until we meet again, May God hold you in the palm of His hand. (a traditional Irish blessing)
- 3) A Blessing from the Apostle Paul: May God, out of his glorious riches, strengthen you with power through his Spirit in your inner being, that Christ may dwell in your heart through faith. May you, being rooted and established in love, have power, together with all the Lord's holy people, to grasp how wide and long and high and deep is the love of Christ, and may you know this love that surpasses knowledge, that you may be filled to the measure of all the fullness of God. May God, who is utterly able, do immeasurably more for you and in you than all you can ever ask or imagine. (based on Ephesians 3:16-19, NIV)
- 4) A Sevenfold Blessing from Scripture: May God be gracious to you. May God bless you. May God make his face shine upon you. May you be strengthened with all power according to God's glorious might. May you be filled with joy. May God give you the desire of your heart, and make all your plans succeed. (Drawn from Psalm 67:1, Colossians 1:11, Psalm 20:4) You may want to combine one or more of these blessings, or add to them specific prayers of your heart for your father (or grandfather, or other father figure). And you don't have to pray these blessings only on Father's Day, of course. They work all year round.



#### **How to Observe National Men's Health Month**

- **b.** A conversation starter Men's Health Month gets people talking about health, which gets people acting about health. Gyms get joined, appointments get made, and resolutions get promised. It's a beautiful thing. Join in!
- c. An excuse for pampering Lots of things that are good for your body are also good for your soul! Play some golf, get a massage, take an extra long nap. It's all healthy, and if anyone asks the occasion, you've got an answer at the ready: Men's Health Month!




